 GRANITE	<p>Heat Resistant</p> <p>Scrath Resistant</p> <p>Hardest and most durable natural stone</p>	<p>Use penetrating sealant</p> <p>Wipe with a clean, damp cloth and a small amount of soapy water.</p>	<p>Use ammonia, bleach, or any cleaning products with solvents or caustics</p>
 MARBLE	<p>Heat Resistant</p> <p>Scratches easily</p> <p>Stains easily</p>	<p>Add a sealant</p> <p>Clean up any spills</p> <p>Wipe with clean, slightly damp cloth and dry with soft towel</p>	<p>Use bleach, or any acidic or abrasive household cleaners</p> <p>Place hot cooking pans directly on surface</p>
 QUARTZ	<p>Stain resistant</p> <p>Will not easily scrath or chip</p>	<p>Wash with soft cloth, warm water and mild soap</p> <p>Use a cutting board</p>	<p>Use abrasive household cleaners</p> <p>Place heat generating appliance or hot cooking pans directly on surface</p>
 QUARTZITE	<p>Naturally strong and durable</p> <p>Heat Resistant</p>	<p>Use a sealant</p> <p>Wipe frequently with a damp cloth and small amount of mild soap</p>	<p>Use abrasive household cleaners</p> <p>Leave spills sitting</p>
 SOAPSTONE	<p>Smooth matte feel</p> <p>Color darkens with age</p> <p>Heat resistant</p> <p>Stain resistant</p> <p>Chemical Resistant</p>	<p>Clean with soap &amp; water</p> <p>Apply mineral oil to the surface weekly</p>	<p>Expect it not to scrath or dent</p>
